Medication

If your child requires any medication to be administered at school in 2023 please ensure the **MEDICAL MANAGEMENT PLAN** is signed by your child's medical practitioner.

Parents/legal guardians must also complete a MEDICAL AUTHORITY FORM.

We can no longer administer medication without both documents being completed in full - this includes both over the counter or prescription medication.

# NB: An 'in date' Anaphylaxis Plan and Asthma Management Plan signed by your child's health practitioner does replace a medical management plan.

#### Education in Faith

#### Sacramental Enrolment

As a Catholic School, St. Margaret's provides sacramental preparation programs to support families as they progress their children through their faith journey. The usual progression is:

Reconciliation – Year 3 Eucharist – Year 4 Confirmation – Year 6



(Sometimes things like later grade entry, illness, family choice or holidays can mean children in other years 'catch up' with sacraments and these students are accommodated for once parents enrol them in a sacrament).

Sacramental preparation programs consist of education in faith lessons delivered through classroom programs and special sacrament specific lessons to prepare students for their participation in the celebration of receiving that sacrament. We also provide preparation sessions for parents and students to help families guide their children in their faith journey.

#### 2023 Sacramental Programs

**Reconciliation** – usually Year 3

Family Preparation Evening – Online session with Maria Forde – October 24<sup>th</sup> at 7pm Sacrament of Reconciliation – November (date to be confirmed) Celebration will take place at school.

*Eucharist* – *usually Year 4* Family Preparation Evening – 'The Emmaus Meal' – August 9<sup>th</sup>, 6.30pm Sacrament of First Eucharist (also known as First Holy Communion) – Sunday, August 20<sup>th</sup>

#### Confirmation – usually Year 6

Preparation Day (this year the students will have a preparation **day** involving attending mass at the Basilica and activities in the parish hall, rather than a night meeting) Sacrament of Confirmation – Thursday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> 7pm


#### Baptism

We also provide preparation for the families of any <u>school-aged</u> students who wish to be baptised. (Preparation program run in Term Two – see Marg)

#### Enrolment

For your child to participate in Sacramental programs, the parish has set aside 8 masses to choose from, so that you may enrol your child in a sacrament. All parents who wish their child to receive a sacrament this year are *expected* to attend *one* of these masses. Teachers from a parish school will be present to help you fill in an enrolment form at the conclusion of the mass.

Your decision to enrol your child in one of our parish schools is indicative of your desire to have your child educated in the Catholic faith. This is your opportunity to demonstrate your commitment to your child's faith education. It also illustrates your own commitment to your Catholic faith.



Please return the Sacramental Mass RSVP as soon as possible, if you haven't already done so.

# A Lenten Reflection with Maria Forde




"To be free we must be able to give up what is old and so answer God's will today and tomorrow" - *Ernst Käsemann*
